## REVISION OF CERTIFICATION CRITERIA FOR STEEL (GWP) PRODUCTS

### Background

1 This circular informs the industry of the revised Steel Global Warming Potential (GWP) criteria under the Singapore Green Building Product (SGBP) certification scheme. This document outlines the key updates, while the full, revised criteria will be accessible via the SGBC Online portal upon application.

### Overview of Changes

2 In response to the feedback from the industry and to better support the evolving industry needs, the **GWP** thresholds for each tick rating have been recalibrated as shown in the table below.

Revised Section B Requirement: Steel (GWP)	
Tick Rating	Minimum GWP
1	≤ 1700 kgCO <sub>2</sub> e/tonne
2	< 1350 kgCO <sub>2</sub> e/tonne
3	< 1000 kgCO <sub>2</sub> e/tonne
4	< 650 kgCO <sub>2</sub> e/tonne

### Implementation Timeline

3 The revised and consolidated criteria will take effect from 13<sup>th</sup> April 2026 and applies to all application submitted on or after this date.

4 Existing SGBP certificates for all products already certified under the Steel (GWP) category will remain valid until their expiry date.
