REVISION OF CERTIFICATION CRITERIA FOR GREEN WALL PANEL AND GREEN WALL TRAY PRODUCTS

Background

1 This circular serves to inform the industry that products seeking certification under the Green Wall Panel and Green Wall Tray categories will now be evaluated using a single set of criteria under the Singapore Green Building Product (SGBP) certification scheme. It also provides an overview of the changes, while the full criteria will be made available upon submission of applications via the SGBC Online portal.

Overview of Changes

Changes applicable to Green Wall Panel category only

2 There is no change in the technical requirement for **Air Emission Performance** for products under the Green Wall Panel category, but the requirement will be moved from Section B to Section A, adopting the following limits: TVOC \leq 1.0 mg/ m³ and Formaldehyde \leq 0.1 mg/m³.

3 The **End-of-Life** requirement, which is currently a supplementary requirement will be made mandatory for products under the Green Wall Panel category. Applicants would be required to show evidence of policy or procedure (e.g. take-back policy or recycling service for corporate clients or general consumers) outlining the treatment of product at the end of the product's lifecycle.

Changes applicable to Green Wall Panel and Green Wall Tray categories

4 The **Recycled Content and/or Renewable Raw Material** requirement for the Green Wall Tray category has been revised with the addition of third-party verification of recycled content for the highest tier (4 tick). This revised requirement will also be added as a new requirement to the Green Wall Panel category.

5 The **Durability** requirement for the Green Wall Tray category has been revised with the removal of Wind Resistance Test Report and Endorsement by Professional Engineer. This revised requirement will also be added as a new requirement to the Green Wall Panel category.

6 Under the **Corporate Green Initiative – (i) Carbon Footprint Course** and **(ii) Corporate Green Initiative – Carbon Footprint Report** requirements will be replaced by the **(i) Diversity, Equity and Inclusion** and **(ii) Corporate Responsibility - Supporting Local Community** requirements. Applicants can meet these requirements by providing relevant documents that show the company's efforts to promote Diversity, Equity and Inclusion practices and their contributions to the local community.

Implementation Timeline

7 The revised and consolidated criteria will take effect from 1st April 2026 and applies to all application submitted on or after this date.

8 Existing SGBP certificates for all products already certified under the Green Wall Tray and Green Wall Panel categories will remain valid until their expiry date.
